**THE AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN TO THE WINNERS AT PROGETTO FUOCO IN VERONA ON 27
FEBRUARY 2016**

On 13 January, the competition panel for “The fireplace, the stove and all around” met in the Milan office of the ADI Industrial Design Association.

The ADI-backed competition was launched by Piemmeti for Progetto Fuoco, the international biennial exhibition of wood-fired heating and energy systems and equipment, which will take place at Verona Exhibition Centre from 24 to 28 February 2016.

The aim of the competition is to promote designs for specific settings and items that highlight the value of fireplaces and stoves as highly appealing gathering places in the home.

No fewer than 157 entries were received, all of which revolved around the significant part played in the home by a wood-fired source of heating. In addition to a plaque, the following amounts will be awarded for the top three projects: a 1st prize of €6,000, a 2nd prize of €4,000 and a 3rd prize of €2,000. There were also nine special mentions.

“The quality and quantity of the projects showed that there is a huge amount of interest in the subject among designers today and that the traditional values associated with the hearth – seen as the centre not only of family life but also of broader social relationships – are highly topical,” stated Luciano Galimberti. “The ADI is delighted to have contributed to an initiative that has collected and promoted design solutions which perfectly reflect the approach to home living of people today.”

“The high standard of the entries made things very tough for the panel, which selected 12 finalists from the 157 projects presented,” noted Ado Rebuli. “We wanted to show our appreciation for all of these extremely interesting creations, so we were delighted to give out nine special mentions as well as selecting the three winners. All of the projects will be on display in Hall 5 of the exhibition centre throughout the event.”

The names of the winners will be announced during the awards ceremony, which will take place during Progetto Fuoco in Verona at 11.30 am on Saturday 27 February 2016.
